The GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION reserves the right to change any rates and any of the Terms and Conditions at any time and without prior notice.

All work is carried out by the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION on the understanding that the client has agreed to the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION terms and conditions.

Copyright is retained by the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION on all work provided including words, pictures, ideas, visuals and illustrations, unless specifically released in writing and after all costs have been settled.

If a choice of service is presented, only one solution is given by the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION as fulfilling the contract. All other works remain the property of GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION, unless agreed in writing that this arrangement has been changed.

Description

As an Association registered club, the GBMAA will help to build your business acumen in areas such as marketing, psychology and motivation. Association Acceptance

All martial arts academies/schools gaining membership to the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION are required to have a GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION license. In order to receive and retain a license, all schools must adhere to the mandatory requirements, as defined in the most recent GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION club handbook. The Association license certificate is awarded to academies/schools annually and must be displayed prominently within the corresponding licensed academy/school. The GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION reserves the right to evaluate clubs/academies to determine whether they meet the qualification requirements for a GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION license.

All member clubs are expected to run, teach and market their clubs in accordance with the standards set by the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION. All chief instructors will be held responsible for the implementation of all license requirements. Failure to meet the minimum requirements will result in not being granted a license or having any license granted revoked, at any time, throughout any licensed period. A revoked license can be reinstated at the discretion of the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION.

Note: Serious Breaches in License requirements can result in academies/schools having their membership to the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION revoked.

Service Charges

A Membership Fee of £50 is needed to register an academy/school with the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION. Costs for additional services to be provided by GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION will be provided to the client in the form of estimate/quotation. At the time of the client's signed acceptance of this estimate/quotation, indicating acceptance of the Terms & Conditions, the service will become fully payable (**100% of the quoted amount**) at the time of estimate or quotation acceptance.

Refund/Cancellations

Application fees for GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION membership are **non-refundable after 14 days**. All indemnity and license policy fees are non-refundable. Additional services, payment are non refundable. (Additional services include but are not limited to: Seminars, Billing & Support, Grading, Competitions, Licensing, Marketing and Consultation, Member Management Services, Insurance etc.) If membership is wished to be cancelled, the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION must be notified immediately. Complaints

If the instructor has followed the above steps, the director will call a grievance committee hearing within 24 hours of receipt of the report. Such a committee hearing will include the director(s), instructor(s), and/or additional appropriate staff members. The hearing may be scheduled on-line or via teleconference to accommodate those involved. In addition, all persons involved with the incident must be present at the scheduled time of the hearing. The GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION director(s) will immediately meet in the absence of others involved to review the evidence and vote on a decision. The decision of the committee will be communicated immediately.

Privacy Policy

What Information is the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION gathering about its visitors and how is it being used?

Every computer connected to the Internet is provided with a domain name (e.g. someispname.com) and an IP Address (e.g. 192.164.13.145). When a visitor requests a page from within the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION website, our Web Servers automatically identify and log the HTTP request that is made to our Web Server. By itself, this information reveals nothing personal about you. In fact, the only information that we automatically gather and log is as follows:

1. The IP Address of the Site that may have referred you.
2. Your IP Address.

4. The Product Identifier for Version and Make of Browser (e.g. Internet Explorer®)
5. The Operating System platform that you may be running (e.g. Macintosh® or Windows®)
6. Search Words or Terms that are passed from a Search Engine (e.g. Google® or Yahoo!®)
7. Information readily available and stored in your Adobe® Flash System. Capabilities Object.

There is absolutely nothing special about the information just described, and the practice of collecting this data has been generally standardized by virtually every Web Server on the Internet today.

The purpose for this information is actually two-fold. One, the GREAT BRITAIN MARTIAL ARTS ASSOCIATION has found it advantageous to examine visitor traffic in its aggregate, so that we can ensure maximum compatibility for the various Browsers and Operating Systems that visit our site.
